### JUNIOR (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place)

Black Drum, Croaker, Dolphin, Flounder, Gaff top, Grunt, Hardhead, King, Ladyfish, Piggy, Redfish (slot only), Sand Trout, Shark, Spadefish, Spanish Mackerel, Speckled Trout, V. Snapper, Whiting.

### ADULT (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place)

Offshore: Amberjack, Billfish, (catch and release), Dolphin, Grouper, King, Ling, Red Snapper, Tuna, Wahoo.

In Shore: Flounder, Gaff Top, Giggled Flounder, Mangrove Snapper, Redfish (slot only), Shark, Spanish Mackerel, Speckled Trout.

>The tournament is active unless there is a marine weather advisory. Offshore days will be canceled if seas are 3 feet or higher.

>Tournament updates, leader board and pictures updated by Civic email blast.

>Winners announced and awards presented at the Treasure Island Fish Fry on SATURDAY, JULY 3, 2021.

>Any fish you bring to a weigh-in must be legally caught and retainable per Texas Parks and Wildlife and/or National Marine Fisheries Rules and Regulations.

>You must be registered **before** catching fish for weigh-ins. All fish must be taken by legal means on specified fishing days and subject to rules of the above agencies.
